**Report on the study day:**

**"Using Information and Communication Technology in Education during the Quarantine Period, the National Education System in Algeria as a Model"**

**September 18, 2023**

This study day entitled: «Using Information and Communication Technology in Education (TICE) During the Quarantine Period. The National Education System in Algeria as a Model", is part of a joint research project between the National Institute for Research in Education and UNESCO, under the theme: "Quarantine and its effects on education in Algeria". The study day began with a speech by the Director of the National Institute for Research in Education, **Pr. Radia BERNAOUI**, in which she expressed concerns about this dangerous global phenomenon, where interaction with other becomes a crucial issue in teaching, learning and innovation for sustainable development, and in order to ensure the proper functioning of the educational system and diversify existing solutions.

The study day included three scientific sessions. The first session was entitled "The Practice of Information and Communication Technologies for Teaching (TICE)", presented by **Dr. Dahmani Mahdia** and chaired by **Dr. Chebib Abdelkarim**, and **Dr. Abdelhamid Abi Ismail** as the session's rapporteur. The second session was conducted by **Dr. Riad Zerouki** and focused on: "Experiences of Distance Learning Worldwide during the Coronavirus (Covid-19) Pandemic" and chaired by **Dr. Nabila Bousbaia**, and **Dr. Sabrina Kebal** as the session's rapporteur. The last session was entitled «Evaluation of distance learning conditions among education actors ", which included three presentations on educational actors. The first presentation entitled: "the Use of TICE during the Lockdown among Teachers» was delivered by **Dr. Kebal Sabrina**. The second presentation was given by **Dr. Kihel Basma** and focused on: "the Use of TICE during the Lockdown among School Directors". The third presentation entitled: "The Use of TICE during the Lockdown among Pupils and Parents" was presented by **Dr. Adouane Asma**.

These scientific presentations were followed by a general discussion that enriched the content of the presentations, resulting in several recommendations. The Director of the Institute expressed her gratitude to all participants, including the speakers, organizers and attendees, for their contributions to the success of this event.
