The National Institute for Research in Education hosted a study day with expert professors, entitled: "**A Collaborative Working Environment and Scientific Research Adapted to Success**", on Monday, October 16, 2023 at the Institute's headquarters in El Achour.

The event began with a speech by **Pr.
