Report on the Virtual National Seminar on
Teaching during the COVID-19 pandemic. Experiences of education
stakeholders in Algeria

October 31, 2023

As part of the partnership between the National Institute for Research in Education and UNESCO, inserted in the research project entitled "Confinement and its Impacts on Teaching in Education in Algeria. The Needs for a National Platform of Educational Resources for Sustainable Development", the National Institute for Educational Research organized a virtual national seminar entitled "Teaching during the COVID-19 pandemic. Experiences of education stakeholders in Algeria, on October 31, 2023.

The event was attended by a group of teachers and researchers, from inside and outside the Institute, including teacher-researchers, inspectors and education experts. coming together to discuss the challenges of education during the Covid-19 pandemic, through the experiences of education stakeholders during lockdown, exploring research into the challenges of the post-Covid era.

Following the national anthem, **Pr Radia Bernaoui**, Director of the National Institute for Research in Education, delivered her welcome speech, emphasizing the importance of reviewing the experiences and initiatives undertaken by the different actors of the education during the confinement period. The objective was to understand the specific challenges and needs identified from the perspective of these stakeholders, in order to formulate comprehensive and effective strategies for future teaching and learning.

The seminar took place in a plenary session chaired by **Ms. Zohra Touil**, consisting of two presentations. The first intervention, entitled "Pedagogical engineering and content production: new challenges and opportunities", was presented by **Dr Zinedine Seffadj**, followed by the

intervention entitled “Governance of the education system: synthesis and perspectives”, presented by **Dr Abdelkarim Chebieb**.

This meeting was a real opportunity to address various topics presented during the virtual national seminar. In the same context, the speakers and guests expressed their thanks for the choice of this important theme, formulating a series of recommendations focused on different teaching methods during health crises.
