Call for papers

As part of the publication of the volume 14 N: 01 which will appear in June 2024, “Educ Research” an international, biannual and peer-reviewed scientific journal, edited by the National Institute for Research in Education is launching a call for papers.

Educ Research is an international biannual and peer-reviewed scientific journal. It is edited by the National Institute for Research in Education (NIRE) since 2011 and distributed, via the Algerian Scientific Journal Platform (ASJP). It is specialized in the field of education and open to all scientific contributions in research-action.

The editorial line is based on an evaluation, by an international reading committee, publishing original research articles, synthesis and scientific notes in the field of educational sciences in several languages (Arabic, French, English).

Educ Research aims to promote research work intended for a specialized audience (researchers and teacher-researchers). It is also aimed at national education executives (inspectors, pedagogues, didacticians, psychologists, etc.) to support them in their professional activities; in particular to help promote a quality school. It offers doctoral students and young researchers the opportunity to publish their research work.

The journal is distributed in Open Access, specifies and declares copyright, and ensures compliance with the code of ethics and professional conduct.

Educ Research deals with all aspects related to research and development in educational technologies, to the socio-cultural, economic and educational system environment, to the analysis of educational practices, to educational evaluation, to the philosophy of education, educational innovation and governance, assurance and quality, Educational sociology, psychometric, educational psychology.

Its vocation is to accommodate any original text, dealing with interactions between education and its environment and integrating Information and Communication Technologies for Education (ICT).

The editorial board comprises a publication director, an editor-in-chief, a co-editor-in-chief, two editorial secretaries, a scientific committee, a reading committee and linguistic correctors.

Publication Requirements in the Journal:

Articles addressed to didactic must be submitted under the following requirements:

- Articles (submitted papers) must be unpublished and original and should not be subject to review in another journal and not be extracted from university theses.
- The research article must be written in one of the following languages: Arabic, English, and French. It should also include two abstracts of approximately 150 words for each abstract, one in the writing language and the other in English if the article is written in Arabic. If the article is written in a foreign language, the abstract must be written in Arabic. Each abstract must be followed by five (05) keywords.
- Content written in English (title, summary, keywords) should not be translated automatically.
- The length of the article must be 12 to 20 pages maximum, including footnotes, tables and illustrations.
- Prioritize scientific contributions in research- action.
- The body of the text must be written in Sakkal Majalla, size: 16 for arabic language and in Times New Roman, size: 12 for foreign languages.
- Bibliographical references should be based on the international standard ISO 690-2010.
- It is necessary to respect the Template of the journal.
- Submitted articles cannot be removed once viewed by the editor. It is also prohibited to send it to other journals during the evaluation period.
- After publication, the article should not be submitted to any other journal or party, and should not be submitted to other databases or websites only after obtaining written permission from the editor-in-chief.
- The article is subject to a double anonymous expertise, it is then either accepted as it is, or refused, or accepted and being subject to major or minor corrections. The author will be informed of any decision.
- All ideas published in the journal reflect the opinions of their authors and not of the journal.
- The researcher must respect the principle of scientific honesty to avoid any form of scientific plagiarism in accordance with Order No. 1082 of December 27, 2020 laying down the rules relating to the prevention and fight against plagiarism.
- All rights of the journal Educ Research are reserved.
